Restoring the (working) system from backup:

This guide applies where you wish to restore your working system to a previous time.

Note that your system will be restored to the earlier date and time when the backup you are restoring to was taken. Any software, documents, music, emails etc. loaded on your system since that backup was taken will be lost upon restore and need to be manually re-loaded.




Follow all instructions carefully and always ensure you have a point of recovery to return to in case you encounter difficulties when implementing this process.

Guide starts here:


1. Open / start the B&R 10.2 software program.
2. Select the 'Restore' option from the left-hand side menu from within the Backup & Recovery program




3. Select 'Next' at the 'Welcome to the Restore Wizard' window




4. Highlight/select the backup entry you wish to restore on the 'Browse for Archive' window and select 'Next' to proceed




5. To restore your entire system, highlight/select the partition to be restored at the 'Which Files and Folders to Restore' screen and select "Next" to proceed.




6. Select.highlight the target location for the restore and select 'Next' to proceed.



7. Select 'Next' at the 'Restore results' preview screen




8. Select 'Finish' at the 'Completing the Restore Wizard' screen



9. Select 'Apply' from the program menu bar to commit and start the restore



10. Reply 'Yes' at the pending changes window to confirm the restore is to proceed



11. The Restore process will start and shortly after request that the computer be restarted to complete the restore operation – Select the 'Restart the computer' option to begin the restore process.



Your system will re-start and begin the restore process.

On successful completion of the Restore, your system will automatically be re-started with the system restored to the point in time the chosen backup was taken.
